JUDGING: Commences 9.00 a.m. sharp on Saturday, 25th June 2022.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday 20th June 2022.
Entry Fees must accompany entry forms.

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per entry.
All competitors must pay admission fees.

PRIZE MONEY: First \$5.00, Second \$3.50, Third Ribbon

All prizes awarded at the Show must be collected on the day or as soon as possible in cases where there is a protest. All prizes not collected will be forfeited to the Association.

Prize- winners of over \$50.00 - (Forms available at Show Sec.'s office) G.S.T. registered prize- winners claim G.S.T. on prize money by issuing a Tax Invoice including A.B.N. OR Hobbyists form must be filled in OR 48.5% will be withheld.

Ribbons will be presented for all sections. Prizes will be presented for Grand Champions, Supreme Champions and Supreme Exhibit.

N.B. CATTLE TICK TREATMENT FOR STOCK RETURNING TO CLEAN AREAS.

Rosewood showground does not have an approved livestock spraying facility. Exhibitors returning to the Cattle Tick protected and free areas will need to contact the D.P.I. and book in for a return treatment at one of their clearing centres. A minimum of 48 hours notice is required.

Sponsorship arriving following printing of the schedule is gratefully acknowledged and will be announced at ringside during judging on show day. All Ribbons will be provided by the Rosewood A & H Assoc. Inc.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Exhibitors are to have waybills correctly completed and have NLIS tags identifying their cattle. Waybills will be sighted by the appointed Stewards and copies retained by the Show Society. All cattle are to be scanned on arrival to the Rosewood Showground in accordance with the National Livestock Identification Scheme. Scanned data will be processed as per guidelines of the National Livestock Identification Scheme.
- 2 Exhibitors are not to interfere with the work of the Stewards or appointed persons undertaking this activity. The Judges's decision is final.
- 3 The **cut-off date** for the age of animals is the **1st June 2022.**
- 4 **The owners name, the animals registered stud name, date of birth and the breed of the animal must be clearly printed on the entry form.**
5. Animals must be entered in one registered breed only.
6. All stud cattle exhibited must be either **calf or adult** registered to their respective herd book and herd number branded and/or tattooed. Proof of registration or eligibility to register must be made available on request.

- 7 Cattle must be **tick free** to protect animals from non-tick areas.
- 8 All **bulls 12 months and over** MUST have a NOSE RING and to be led by nose ring and halter. Bulls under 12 months must have a NOSE GRIP or ring. Other animals must be haltered
- 9 Exhibitors are required to wear protective footwear and are to have enough handlers to prevent unnecessary delay during judging.
- 10 To be eligible to lead an animal, children under the age of 13 years must be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age.
- 11 All exhibits must be the bona-fide property of owner prior to entering the show.
- 12 No discussion is allowed between judges and exhibitors.
- 13 All cattle must remain on the grounds until stewards give permission to remove cattle.
- 14 **ALL EXHIBITORS TO PAY GATE ADMISSION FEES.**
- 15 **SECTIONS:** There will be three sections: **BRITISH BREEDS; TROPICAL BREEDS and EUROPEAN BREEDS.** All breeds are accepted.
- 16 Where one entry only occurs in a class the animal will be judged at champion level.
- 17 All electrical equipment used on grounds must comply with Workplace Health & Safety Act this includes **Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers on all electrical equipment.**

Weigh in at approximately **8:00am**. All Led Steers must be Milk Tooth. All steers must be named and the dominant breed to be listed on the entry form.

Entry Fee: \$7.00 (Incl. G.S.T.)

Led Steers will be judged after Stud Cattle.

- 12 Steer maximum weight 425 kg.
- 13 Senior Steer over 425 kg live weight.

BEEF CATTLE YOUNG PARADERS

Entries for the Beef Cattle Paraders' Competition taken on the morning of the show. A Beef Paraders' Competition will be conducted under the following Q.C.A.S. rules –

- 1 Open to persons under the age of 25 years at 1st April 2020.
- 2 Competitors under 18 years must have approval of parent or guardian to compete and it is the responsibility of a parent or guardian to make arrangements on behalf of the competitor.
- 3 All competitors to be a resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to the competition or be attending a college in Queensland. Entrants residing over the border who can prove an affinity with a Queensland Show are allowed entry by satisfying one of the following criteria:
 - (a) Their address has a Queensland postcode.
 - (b) They have a Queensland phone number.
 - (c) The entrant or the entrant's parents are active working members of that show.
- 4 National winners and judges are not eligible.
- 5 A Competitor can represent only one show society in any sub-chamber final and only one sub-chamber in the state final.

Beef Cattle Young Paraders' Sub-Chamber Final will be held in 2020.

Prize money and ribbon will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Entry into competition is free.
