Conditions of Entry (please read fully and carefully):

- All artwork must be the original work of the entrant, created in the last two years and **not** entered at a previous Rosewood Show.
- Subject matter of artwork must be suitable for **all** show visitors and not depict violence, nudity or obscenity.
- There is a limit of 2 entries per artist per class.
- Entries must be 2D artworks unless otherwise indicated.
- All artwork, **Junior and Open Classes**, must have artists name, title of artwork, medium, Class entered and price (if for sale) or NFS (if not for sale) **clearly and securely** marked on the back of the artwork.
- A 10% commission will be charged on artwork sold at Rosewood show.
- **No artwork is to exceed 100 cm by 100 cm including the frame.** If artwork is outside of these measurements it may not be hung.
- All open class artwork must be able to be securely hung. This means D rings securely fixed to the back of the artwork/frame about one third of the way down from the top of artwork with suitable strength framing wire securely wound around each D ring. Artwork on paper must be framed behind glass and prepared for hanging as above. If Chief Steward deems artwork not suitable for hanging it will not be hung.
- Junior artwork is to be framed as per open class or mounted on a sturdy piece of cardboard that allows it to be securely hung.
- Artists are responsible to ensure their artwork is correctly framed.

- All reasonable care will be taken with exhibits but Stewards will not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever while in their custody.
- Open classes are aged 16 and over. Junior classes are as indicated. Juniors aged 16 and over may exhibit in the open class but must pay open class entry fee.
- Entries are to be delivered to the Fine Arts area in the Show Hall on **Sunday 23 and Monday 24 June from 9:00 am - 2:00 pm.**
- **Fees are to be paid into the Rosewood Show bank account: BSB 633-000, Account No. 133617597, clearly marked with your name and (Fine Arts). Entry forms and a copy of the receipt are to be emailed to rosewoodshow@live.com.au before delivery of artwork to Chief Steward.**
- Stewards can transfer entries to another class, not display or disqualify.
- All entries are to be on display for the duration of the Show.
- Fine Arts entries & prizes can be collected between **9.00am – 11.00am Sunday 30 June.**
- Alternative times for delivery or collection by arrangement with Chief Steward.
- To prevent loss or damage, **ONLY** Fine Arts stewards will hang/remove entries from stands.
- There will be closed judging and judge's decision is final.
- By placing an entry into the Rosewood Show you consent to have your artwork photographed for promotional purposes for the Rosewood show.
