Rosewood showground does not have an approved livestock spraying facility. Exhibitors returning to the Cattle Tick protected and free areas will need to contact the D.P.I. and book in for a return treatment at one of their clearing centres. A minimum of 48 hours notice is required.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Exhibitors are to have waybills correctly completed and have NLIS tags identifying their cattle. Waybills will be sighted by the appointed Stewards and copies retained by the Show Society. All cattle are to be scanned on arrival at the Rosewood Showground in accordance with the National Livestock Identification Scheme. Scanned data will be processed as per guidelines of the National Livestock Identification Scheme.
- 2 Exhibitors are not to interfere with the work of the Stewards or appointed persons undertaking this activity. The Judges's decision is final.
- 3 The cut-off date for the age of animals is the 1st June 2024.
- 4 The owners name, the animals registered stud name, date of birth and the breed of the animal must be clearly printed on the entry form.
- 5. Animals must be entered in one registered breed only.
- 6. All stud cattle exhibited must be either **calf or adult** registered to their respective herd book and herd number branded and/or tattooed. Proof of registration or eligibility to register must be made available on request.
- 7 Cattle must be **tick free** to protect animals from non-tick areas.
- 8 All **bulls 12 months and over** MUST have a NOSE RING and to be led by nose ring and halter. Bulls under 12 months must have a NOSE GRIP or ring. Other animals must be haltered
- 9 Exhibitors are required to wear protective footwear and are to have enough handlers to prevent unnecessary delay during judging.
- 10 To be eligible to lead an animal, children under the age of 13 years must be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age.
- 11 All exhibits must be the bona-fide property of owner prior to entering the show.
- 12 No discussion is allowed between judges and exhibitors.
- 13 All cattle must remain on the grounds until stewards give permission to remove cattle.
- 14 ALL EXHIBITORS TO PAY GATE ADMISSION FEES.
- 15 SECTIONS: There will be three sections: BRITISH BREEDS; TROPICAL BREEDS and EUROPEAN BREEDS. All breeds are accepted.
- 16 Where one entry only occurs in a class the animal will be judged at champion level.
- 17 All electrical equipment used on grounds must comply with Workplace Health & Safety Act this includes **Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers on all electrical** equipment.
