HOME GROWN CUT FLOWERS (glass container provided)

1. One rose - any colour
2. Three roses - bud to full bloom,
3. One miniature or floribunda rose
4. One perfumed rose – any colour
5. One cut flower, single bloom other than rose
6. Three cut flowers, single bloom or trusses other than rose
7. One geranium - single
8. One geranium - double
9. One bougainvillea stem / bract
10. One Cut Flowering Native Flower / Shrub / tree stem or bract
11. One cut branch of shrub or tree in flower (not Native)

HOME GROWN ORCHIDS (in pots)

12. One Cattleya in flower
13. One Cymbidium in flower
14. One Phalaenopsis in flower
15. One mini Phalaenopsis in flower
16. One Epidendron in flower
17. One Dendrobium in flower
18. Any other orchid not provided for in flower

WEEDS – (Must consist of 3 different varieties in a recycled container)
