

# FINE ARTS 2025

**Entry Fee:** \$5.00 per entry - Open classes.  
\$1.00 per entry - Junior classes.

16 years and older can enter open classes but must pay open class entry fee.

**Prizes:** Cards for First, Second, Third and Highly Commended placegetters  
Card and Ribbon for Champion and Reserve Champion in both open and junior classes.

Prize money for Class 1-7      1st - \$50      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$20

Prize money for Class 8-11      1st - \$10      2<sup>nd</sup> - \$5

## **Conditions of Entry (please read fully and carefully):**

- All artwork must be the original work of the entrant, created in the last two years and **not** entered at a previous Rosewood Show.
- Subject matter of artwork must be suitable for **all** show visitors and not depict violence, nudity or obscenity.
- There is a limit of 2 entries per artist per class.
- Entries must be 2D artworks unless otherwise indicated.
- All artwork, **Junior and Open Classes**, must have artists name, title of artwork, medium, Class entered and price (if for sale) or NFS (if not for sale) **clearly and securely** marked on the back of the artwork.
- A **10% commission** will be charged on artwork sold at Rosewood show.
- BSB and Account Number must be provided as all prize money and sales will be deposited into this account.
- **No artwork is to exceed 100 cm by 100 cm including the frame.** If artwork is outside of these measurements it may not be hung.
- All open class artwork must be able to be securely hung. This means D rings securely fixed to the back of the artwork/frame about one third of the way down from the top of artwork with suitable strength framing wire securely wound around each D ring. Artwork on paper must be framed behind glass and prepared for hanging as above. If Chief Steward deems artwork not suitable for hanging it will not be hung.
- Junior artwork is to be framed as per open class or mounted on a sturdy piece of cardboard that allows it to be securely hung.
- Artists are responsible to ensure their artwork is correctly framed.
- All reasonable care will be taken with exhibits but Stewards will not be responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever while in their custody.
- Open classes are aged 16 and over. Junior classes are as indicated. Juniors aged 16 and over may exhibit in the open class but must pay open class entry fee.

- Entries are to be delivered to the Fine Arts area in the Show Hall on **Sunday 22 and Monday 23 June from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm.**
- **Fees are to be paid into the Rosewood Show bank account: BSB 633-000, Account No. 133617597, clearly marked with your name and (Fine Arts). Entry forms and a copy of the receipt are to be emailed to [rosewoodshow@live.com.au](mailto:rosewoodshow@live.com.au) before delivery of artwork to Chief Steward.**
- Please bring your original entry form with your artwork for processing.
- Stewards can transfer entries to another class, not display or disqualify.
- All entries are to be on display for the duration of the Show.
- Fine Arts entries & prizes can be collected between **9.00am – 11.00am Sunday 29 June 2025.**
- Alternative times for delivery or collection by arrangement with Chief Steward.
- To prevent loss or damage, **ONLY** Fine Arts stewards will hang/remove entries from stands.
- There will be closed judging and judge's decision is final.
- By placing an entry into the Rosewood Show you consent to have your artwork photographed for promotional purposes for the Rosewood show.

### **Open Classes**

- Class 1          Portrait – any medium
- Class 2          Drawing – graphite/coloured pencil/charcoal/pen and ink (any subject)
- Class 3          Abstract – any medium
- Class 4          Landscape/streetscape – any medium
- Class 5          Seascape – any medium
- Class 6          Animal or bird – any medium
- Class 7          Flora – any medium
- Class 8          Drawing or painting of building, streetscape, landscape or iconic person or feature of the local 4340 postcode area – any medium.
- Class 9          Still Life – any subject – any medium

### **Junior Classes**

- Class 8          5-6 years – subject to be 'My favourite animal or pet' – any medium
- Class 9          7-8 years – subject to be 'My favourite animal or pet' - any medium
- Class 10        9-11 years – subject to be 'Day at the Beach' - any medium
- Class 11        12-14 years - any subject, any medium
- Class 12        15-17 years - any subject, any medium
