- All work is to be unwashed, except patchwork entries. Exhibitor's name & class number to be attached to each piece of work (Including each piece of a Collection) before being brought into be exhibited.
- All work is to be new, not worn or used. No bought work.
- All articles to be new and not have won a previous prize.
- Only 3 entries into each category will be accepted.

JUDGING: Judging will commence from 9.30am Wednesday 24 June 2026. Prizes will be available for collection from 9.00am on Sunday 28 June 2026. Prize money will be paid via direct deposit. Please complete the section on the entry form.
